

Heinrich Conrad Friedrich Christian Bremer (1811-1880)

Heinrich, along with his wife, Judith Annette Christiane Goldbeck, and five of their children arrived 1844 in the Republic of Texas from Hanover, Germany. Dissatisfied with political and economical conditions in Hanover and reports extolling the opportunities and land in Texas, the family boarded the ship "Johann Detthard", arriving in Galveston.

They made their way up to the Hill Country by wagon, and settled in the area now known as New Braunfels, thus becoming the first settlers to arrive and among the founders of the new town. Heinrich and Annette are buried in the Bremer Cemetery in Seguin, Guadalupe County, Texas.
