Lead field trips to Republic of Texas historic sites. The Texas Historical Commission has published a Republic of Texas Historical Passport, free at various ROT ROT historical sites. I would like for as many of us as possible to tour the sites, learn about our history, and get our passports stamped! Some of these will be all day (or longer!), and some will be shorter. For the longer ones, I am planning group transport and group meals.

Sunday, July 16, 1837



Texas Navy Commodore H.L.
Thompson ordered the Texas flag
planted on the island of Cozumel,
with a 23-gun salute. In claiming the
island for Texas, Commodore
Thompson commented on the
strategic location, the rich soil, and
the high-quality timber. He is quoted
as saying Cozumel was "one of the
greatest acquisitions to our beloved
country that the Admiral aloft could
have bestowed upon us." True story.
