

## This Month in Republic of Texas History

Monday, April 16, 1838:

The first meeting of the Grand Lodge of the Republic of Texas of the

Masonic Order was held today in Houston, with Grand Master Anson Jones presiding. Dr. Jones was elected Grand Master at a meeting when the representatives of the three Masonic lodges in Texas met this past December, which was chaired by President Sam Houston. The three Texas lodges are located in Houston, Nacogdoches, and San Augustine.

### **Texas Honor Days:**

#### San Jacinto Day: April 21

On this date in 1836, General Sam Houston and the Texas Army defeated Santa Anna's Mexican troops at the Battle of San Jacinto.

An annual celebration is held at the San Jacinto Monument and Battlefield.
