Instead, the new plan for the October field trip is to visit the **Monument Hill State Historic Site**. For those of you unfamiliar with the site, it is the burial place of those who died in the Dawson Massacre of 1842 and the Mier Expedition (the infamous "black bean" incident) in November 1842. The monument and the setting are both beautiful, and I hope you will come explore it. We will have a guided

tour starting at 11:00 am, so we will need to leave Austin by 9:00 am. Transportation is provided for 7 to 15 of us; the cost is \$30, which covers the van, gas and admission. We will stop afterward at Reba's Pizzeria and Deli for lunch. Deadline for letting me know if you are planning to attend is **October 1**st.

This Month In Republic of Texas History

Thursday, August 1, 1839



On this day, 301 town lots were auctioned off for the City of Austin.

The sale brought in a total of \$182,525, and was considered highly successful. The funds were used to help pay for the construction of government buildings in the newly designated Republic of Texas capital.



As of August 1st, our balances were:

Cap One Checking Account:	\$ 5,427.74
Chase Checking Account:	\$ 1,753.92
Chase Scholarship Fund:	\$16,473.03

There are no outstanding checks. We are in the process of closing the Cap One checking account. The lower balance in the Chase checking reflects payment of dues
